We are delighted to announce that the CENTRA Education and Training charity has won a Big Lottery Reaching Communities Fund bid to provide funded dyslexia support sessions to adults and children living in the following postal code areas in Preston, Blackpool and South Ribble:

PR1, PR2, PR3, PR4, PR5, PR6, PR7, PR25, PR26, FY1, FY2, FY3, FY4, FY5, FY6, FY7, FY8

Schools in these areas are eligible to apply to participate in this funded dyslexia support project.

CENTRA will train your existing teaching and support staff to use the simple, highly effective IDL (Indirect Dyslexia Learning) software programme with your pupils and provide ongoing support. The IDL programme will be made available to use with as many pupils as you wish for the duration of the funded project.

The project begins in Autumn 2011. Each eligible organisation will be funded to provide specialist dyslexia support for up to 40 weeks during the education year. Participating organisations will be able to purchase the IDL programme at a nominal fee following completion of the funded project period.
